### Sadler Clinic Breaks Ground for New Medical Building

*Sadler Clinic Breaks Ground for New Medical Building on League Line Road*

MONTGOMERY COUNTY, Texas -- Sadler Clinic in conjunction with Mercan City Place Development, a division of D'Agostino Companies, broke ground November 6, 2008 on its newest medical facility to be located in Conroe, Texas. The facility is scheduled to open in the fall of 2009. The 60,000 square foot medical office building will house an urgent care center, physician's medical office space, and support services. The clinic anticipates other services offered at the new site will include MRIs, plain film X-Rays, and mammography.

The ground breaking ceremony included speeches by Ronnie Heft, COO of Sadler Clinic, Dr. Jeremy Laningham, family physician from Sadler Clinic, Lee Mediamolle from Whitney Bank, Chris D'Agostino from D'Agostino Companies, and the Mayor of Conroe, Webb Melder.
